

Download and Save OpenOffice Macro Files for KnowSys

Action

OpenOffice stores macro files as Library modules to support custom menu items. Follow these steps to download and save two macro files.

Step	Action
1	Click anywhere on your desktop to show the <i>Finder</i> menu.
2	Select <i>Go</i> .
3	Press <i>option</i> key to reveal <i>Library</i> submenu, and select <i>Library</i> .
4	Follow this path to location of both macro files: ... > <i>Library</i> > <i>Application Support</i> > <i>OpenOffice</i> >4> <i>user</i> > <i>basic</i> > <i>Standard</i> <i>Note:</i> Your <i>OpenOffice</i> application may use a number different from 4.
5	Rename existing <i>script.xlb</i> Library file to <i>oldscript.xlb</i> to archive it for later use, if desired.
6	Download both macro files from: here and there .
7	Save both downloaded macro files to: ... > <i>OpenOffice</i> >4> <i>user</i> > <i>basic</i> > <i>Standard</i> folder. Be sure to save all files when you close <i>OpenOffice</i> application.
